THE CHARTERS OF STANTON, SUFFOLK

c.1215–1678

1 Settlement of a dispute between Robert chamberlain of St Edmund's¹ and Hervey son of John of Stanton concerning 6d paid annually by Robert to Hervey for land formerly of Odo the parmenter, but which Hervey remits for the time that he is overseas. When he returns, he will satisfy Robert fully and faithfully for the said land. If he does not return, the land and its tenants shall revert to Robert without any objection or hindrance from Hervey's heirs or assigns. If the rent is not paid, Hervey wills that Robert shall distrain on the fee and the tenants, until he is satisfied for the rent and for all expenses incurred as a result of the non-payment.² Witnesses: Adam of Felsham then reeve of St Edmund's, Thomas 'my brother', John of Wretham, Richard 'my uncle', Roger of Stow, William of Hinderclay, Robert the engineer, John son of William, Syger of Stanton, Ralph the clerk, John de Lavardin, Peter son of John, Robert son of Ralph of Rede, Richard of Mildenhall clerk and many others. ¹ R. M. Thomson names Robert as chamberlain 1206–15 and Robert of London 1222–34, and suggests that they may have been one and the same person (R. M. Thomson, 'Obedientiaries of St Edmund's Abbey', *PSIA*, xxxv (1982), 97). The fact that four witnesses, including Ralph the chamberlain's clerk, also appear in 3, in which the chamberlain is named as Robert of London, tends to support this view. The dorse reveals that this charter has passed through the hands of the abbey's *vestiarius*, and has been copied into a register.

² The original version and registered copy show minor differences in spelling (*Eadmundi* and *Edmundi*); in word order (*ballivi vel firmarii* and *firmarii vel ballivi*); and in the choice of words (*roboratum feci* and *roboravi*; *suis* and *eius*). At one point the copyist mixed up his lines, wrote five words and then deleted them.

2 Grant in alms by William son of Adam de Wike to God and the church of St Edmund's and the chamberlain there, for the salvation of his and his ancestors' souls, of the homage and service of Henry son of Gunnilda of Stanton, together with the tenement in Stanton which Henry held of William. Witnesses: Robert de Hernested', Martin of Rokeland, Robert the engineer, William son of Walter of Hepworth, Walter his son, Ralph of Hepworth, Walter of Hinderclay, Ralph his son, William le Neve of Barningham, Robert son of Saher of Stanton, William de Escroft, Robert of Freckenham, Philip de Coleville servants of the lord chamberlain of that time, and many others.

¹ Discrepancies between the two versions mainly concern the spelling of surnames and place-names.

3 Settlement of a dispute between Robert of London, chamberlain of St Edmund's, and John son of William of Stanton in the presence of Richard de l'Isle, abbot of Bury, concerning services and customs from the land of Wolfric.¹ In this chirograph² John agrees to pay 12d annual rent for the land and 12d incremental rent on account of the customs. Witnesses: William then bailiff [*seneschall*'] of St Edmund's, Robert de Wykez', William Ernald', Thomas of the pond ('de Stagno'), Adam of Felsham, William son of Walter, William of Langham, Walter of Hinderclay, William of Hinderclay, Walter of Stanton, Thomas of Stanton, Simon son of Pain, Henry de 'Neketon',³ Philip servant of the chamberlain, Ralph clerk of the same chamberlain. 21 March 1231.

4 Grant in alms by Hervey son of John of the Dale of Stanton to God, the blessed Mary and St Edmund, and to Abbot Edmund and the convent of [St Edmund's], of a piece of land 16 perches and 3 feet in length and 23 feet in breadth with

appurtenances lying in Stanton, between his land and that of John son of John of Stanton, and abutting at one head on his land and at the other on the common pasture of Stanton;¹ to hold and to have to the abbot and convent and their successors, without any claim from Hervey and his heirs in perpetuity. Warranty is granted against all men and women, Jew and Christian.² For this grant and charter Richard of Wicham then chamberlain of St Edmund's gave Hervey 40s sterling. Witnesses: Sir Matthew of Thelnetham, Sir Robert de Wykes, Thomas of Stanton, John son of John, Saier' son of Adam, Robert son of Saher, Thomas son of William, William of the Dale, Richard his son, John son of Laurence, Thomas son of Aspelon, Roger son of Aspelon' and many others. ¹ The shallow valley and farming hamlet of The Dale lay beside Stanton's heath at the northern end of the parish. It gave rise to a prolific local family originally called 'de Dale', 'de la Dale' or 'del Dale', occasionally 'at [*apud*] the Dale') and later simply as 'Dale'. Where any preposition has been used, the name is transcribed in this volume as 'of the Dale'.

² This is the first mention of Jews in this volume; the last occurs in 50. All must pre-date Edward I's expulsion of the Jews in 1290.

5 Grant in alms by Thomas son of John of Stanton to God and [the church of] the blessed Mary and St Edmund and the monks serving God there, of 13 acres of land with appurtenances in the vill of Stanton, namely 6½ acres lying at 'Brendris' between the land of John son of Odo and that of John son of Henry, and abutting at one head on the land of Stanton Hall and at the other on the green way; and 6½ acres lying at 'Gores' between the green ways on each side, and abutting

on the land of Hervey Puddyng of Hepworth. To hold and to have to the monks and their successors freely. Warranty is given against all men, Jew and Christian, and from all suits in the shire, hundred and in all [other] courts. For this gift and charter Richard of Wycham then chamberlain of St Edmund's gave 12 marks of sterling. Witnesses: Sir Matthew of Thelnetham, Sir William of Weston, Berard of Wattisfield, John of Stanton, Saher son of Adam, Robert son of Saher, Thomas son of William, William of the Dale, Richard his son, Thomas son of Richard, Robert of Freckenham and others. Numerals in *italic* type refer to page numbers in the Introduction; numerals in roman type indicate document numbers in this volume. Consecutive numbers are compressed to save space.

A 'w' after a number identifies the witnessing of a charter.

The names of parishes, where not embedded in surnames, are shown in CAPITAL LETTERS; all are in Suffolk unless otherwise indicated.

In the spelling of surnames, an historically dominant or modern form has been adopted; major variant spellings are also given.

The identification of individuals is often made difficult by the frequent repetition of names, and by the variability of descriptions (e.g. in occupations, names of relatives and parishes of residence). The converse is also possible: an individual may appear under more than one description. Where a parish of residence is stated, it is always recorded in the index. It can be assumed that the great majority of people given no parish of residence came from Stanton itself.
